Suggestions on how to use this document:

Suggestion 1: Do-it-Yourself Book

- ★ Print pages 2 to 8 of this document.
- ★ Add your child's name to the space provided on the title page.
- ★ Use the examples below (if needed) to complete your own unique captions on each page of your book.
- ★ Draw a matching picture or glue a matching photograph above each caption.
- ★ Staple all pages of your child's book down the left hand side OR attach one staple to the top left hand corner of the book.
- ★ Present to class! (Your child's teacher will assist with reading if needed).

Suggestion 2: Make a Poster

- ★ Print page 2 of this document and add your child's name in the space provided.
- ★ Paste your title onto the centre of a piece of poster-size cardboard.
- ★ Use the examples below (if needed) to complete your own unique captions on your poster.
- ★ Draw a matching picture or glue a matching photograph above each caption.
- ★ Present to class! (Your child's teacher will assist with reading if needed).

I visited my cousins, Jess and Zack, on their farm.

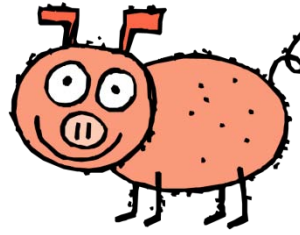
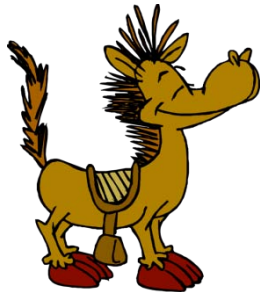
I had a ride on their pet pony called Sugar.
