Suggestions on how to use this document:

Suggestion 1: Ready-to-Print Quiz Booklet

- ★ Print pages 2 to 8 of this document.
- ★ Add your child's name to the space provided on the title page.
- ★ Staple all pages of your child's Quiz Booklet down the left hand side OR attach one staple to the top left hand corner of the booklet.
- ★ Present to class! (Your child's teacher will assist with reading if needed).

Suggestion 2: Do-it-Yourself Quiz Booklet

- ★ Print page 2 of this document and add your child's name to the space provided.
- ★ Print 6 copies of page 9 (ie. the framed, blank booklet page ready for your child's illustrations).

Answer: False. Giant Clams cannot move around at all. They spend their whole life in one spot.



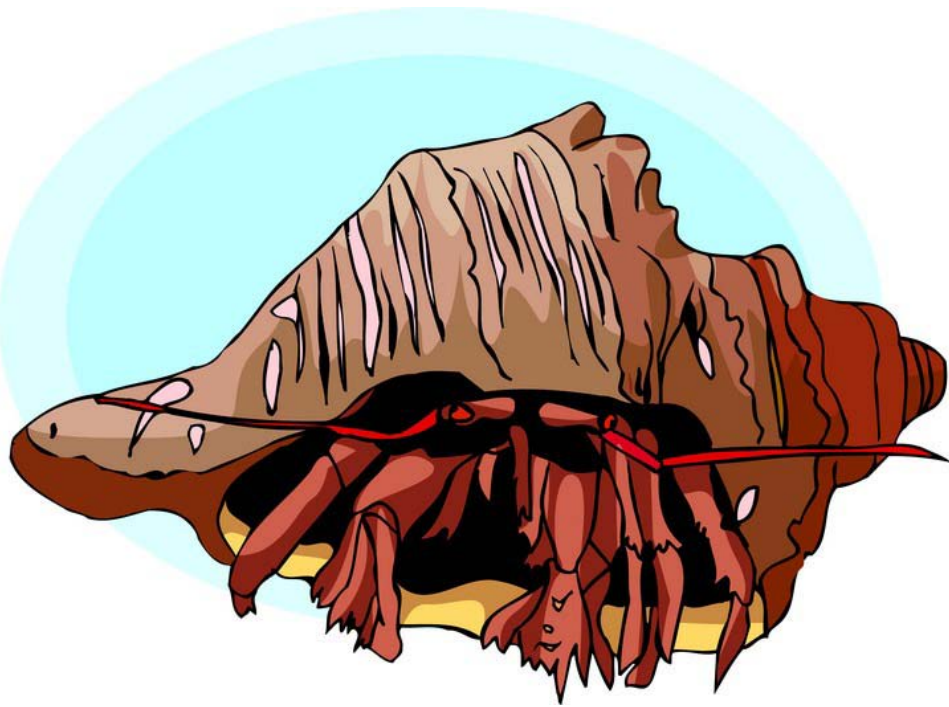
Question: A Stingray is a type of fish. True or False?

Answer: True.



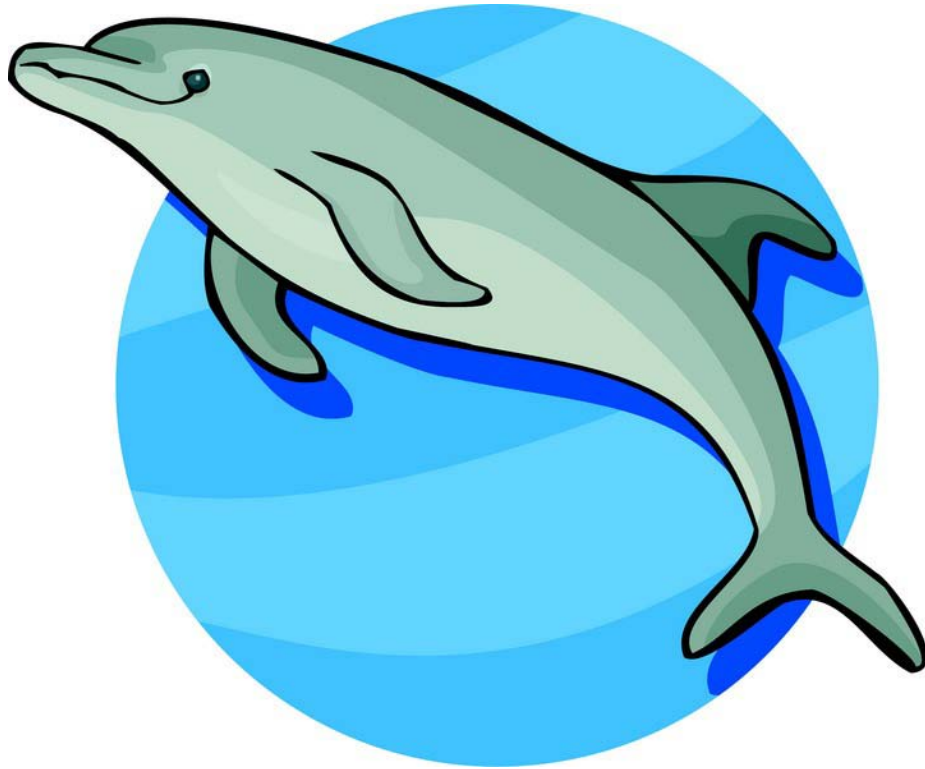
Question: Sea Snakes can breathe under water.
