Suggestions on how to use these ideas:

- ★ “Perform” for your child’s class eg. show a computer animation you have made especially for them.
- ★ Give a fun demonstration eg. launch a “rocket” you have pre-made.
- ★ Teach the class new skills eg. How to create digital art.
- ★ Show the class any special equipment, tools or instruments you use and allow the kids to have a close look, when safe.
- ★ Run a mini-workshop for the entire class eg. choose an interesting and kid-friendly science experiment and involve the whole class in performing the experiment (in small groups).
- ★ Conduct a whole class activity eg. make a movie about the class.
- ★ Consult with your child’s teacher about the possibilities. Most teachers are very welcoming to parents who can bring special talents into the classroom or school yard.
- ★ You don’t need to be an expert!
- ★ **IMPORTANT:** it is your responsibility to make sure all activities are conducted safely.
